Sophie-Véronique Cauchefer-Choplin is Titular Assistant of the Grand Orgue of St. Sulpice and Titular of the Grand Orgue of St Jean-Baptiste de la Salle (Paris), as well as Organ Professor at the Royal College of Music (London). She has an extensive international career, with recitals in Europe, Russia, Japan, Singapore, China, Iceland, United States, Canada and Australia. She is regularly invited to judge organ competitions, and is considered one of the best improvisers of her generation. Her last CD

received a "5 Diapasons" award in June 2008.
